OVERVIEW

Canada's health leaders are looking for ways to revitalize, re-imagine and retool for a changing world. Business as usual is no longer an option. It is now particularly clear that building new or honing existing capabilities is critical.

The National Health Fellows Program will connect our most talented healthcare leaders with skilled, "new power" leaders, educators, complex change facilitators, and mentors to strengthen the networks, behaviors, and evidence-based tools needed to advance health and wellbeing across the broader healthcare system.

FOCUS

From the moment you start the program, you become part of a growing movement charged with reimagining our national health ecosystem.

Over the course of 6 months, you will develop a deep understanding of how to nurture a leadership culture that embraces a systems thinking mindset, gain the practical skills and tools to progress your own leadership capabilities, and put these into practice tackling real life opportunities and challenges within your organization and across the broader health system.

FORMAT

3 x 4-day modules delivered interactively over 6 months.

Learning is collaborative and creative, and includes co-consulting sessions, mentoring, individual and group challenges. Each module builds on what you've learned and prepares you for your role as a National Fellow.

The 3-module, 6-month journey culminates with a national Health Forum Policy Dialogue, where you and your colleagues share your learnings with health policy leaders from across the country.

FELLOWSHIP

Once delegates complete the program, they begin a lifelong relationship with McMaster's Health Leadership Academy. Fellows are asked to mentor, facilitate and speak to future cohorts. Fellows play an active role in co-creating future offerings of the program.
